Section 3316. Who may protest. The Administrator, Chief of Guam Police Department, Director of Public Health and Social Service, Attorney General, Planning Commission, Mayor of the Municipality in which the premises for which a license is sought are located, and every person who has an interest that might be affected adversely by the granting of a license by reason of being an official of a church, hospital, school, contractor's or similar camp, or military reservation, or by reason for have an interest in land located within five hundred (500) feet of the premises for which a license is sought, may protest against the issuance of a license.
