Applicants must meet the following requirements: 1) EDUCATION; (2) EXPERIENCE; (3) PASS EXAMINATION (not applicable to Trainee Real Estate Appraiser); and (4) REPUTATION for Honesty, Truthfulness and Financial Integrity. All documents requested on the application must be attached. Failure to attach all documents requested may result in denial of application.

RENEWAL EVERY TWO (2) YEARS:***The Appraisal License must be renewed every two (2) years with a minimum of twenty-eight (28) hours of continuing education. Seven (7) hours must have been the National USPAP update course. Please note that the fifteen (15) hour National course cannot be substituted for the seven (7) hour National USPAP course for renewal.

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
